## Chapter 4: The Facet of Relationships--Handout

**Standard:** The leader is responsible for the character and quality of interactions between himself and others in the organization.

**Spirit Mover: Love**; A love of humanity—deep connection as human beings; giving and forgiving. "Leadership without love is like a body without a heart."

## **Points to Ponder:**

- Leaders can develop a deep understanding of the gifts and talents of others through building and nurturing relationships.
- People make things happen and bring to life visions, missions, and purposes.
- Develop a caring environment that elevates the human spirit so that everyone feels the importance of their contributions, both individually and collectively.
- Note: This is not a one-way process: the culture of the organization can also impact a leader.
- Perhaps the most challenging relationship is with ourselves
